

Park Downs is a Chalk Downland site and forms part of the Chipstead Downs Site of Special Scientific Interest. You can find semi-mature broadleaf woodland to the north of the site and large swaths of chalk grassland interspersed with scrub to the south. Situated on a steep south-facing slope opposite Banstead Woods, the site boasts spectacular views over the valley. The Banstead Commons Conservators kindly ask visitors to respect this precious habitat and request that you follow the Countryside Code at all times.
