September 2026 through to March 2027

Banstead Commons Conservators volunteers help carry out practical countryside management across the four sites that make up Banstead Commons. If you have some spare time and would like to meet like-minded people while working in the beautiful North Downs countryside, please sign up to our volunteer mailing list.

Weekly volunteer sessions are held every Thursday. Each session is led by a member of staff or a trained lead volunteer, who will guide you through the day's activities and provide a full safety briefing on arrival. No prior experience is necessary, but we ask all volunteers to read our Information and [Safety Awareness Booklet](#) before taking part.

Small, task-focused sessions may also take place on occasional Tuesday and Friday mornings for which we will circulate specific emails outlining the planned task, and volunteers will be asked to register in advance. This approach allows us to be more flexible and to respond more effectively to weather conditions and the specific needs of habitat conservation

Please note that work parties may be cancelled in extreme weather. While not essential, registering in advance is recommended so we can notify you of any changes due to adverse conditions or staff absence.
